Woodhaven Lakes takes pride in the safe and secure environment that we provide for our property owners and guests. To help ensure that your stay is enjoyable, please note the following rules.

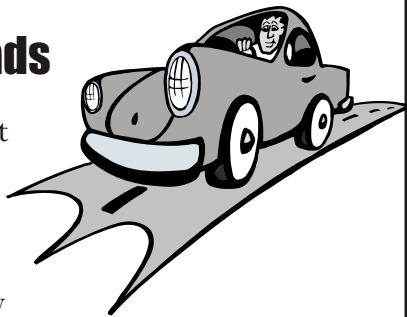
On The Roads

The speed limit is 20 m.p.h throughout Woodhaven, and it is strictly enforced by our Public Safety Department.

All drivers must possess a valid driver's license while driving any type of vehicle. This includes cars, mopeds, scooters, and motorcycles.

Please carry your guest pass or property owner's pass with you at all times when in your vehicle.

Stay alert! There are many pedestrians on Woodhaven's roadways.



On Your Lot

Do not leave your campfire unattended. If you plan on being away from your fire for more than a few minutes, extinguish the fire completely.

Be aware of any weather conditions, such as high winds or very dry conditions, which may make burning dangerous. A sign may be posted at the front gate which prohibits burning at these times.

Be courteous to your neighbors. All lots are private property. Do not enter onto properties without the owner's permission.

About Noise

Rest and relaxation are as much a part of Woodhaven as the many activities and events. Please note that quiet hours are from midnight to 7:00 a.m. This applies to radios, car stereos, televisions, fireside chats, etc.

Woodhaven also has a noise ordinance during non-quiet hours. Please do not play your music, including car stereos, beyond an acceptable limit. As a rule, if your music can be heard from 50 feet away, or two lots, it is too loud.



Common Property and at Woodhaven Facilities



Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on any common grounds. This includes the beach, pavilions, roads, etc.

Vulgar and obscene language is prohibited in public at Woodhaven. Use of this type of language, either personally or from your music, could result in a fine.

All pets must be kept on a leash, even when on your lot. Pets must also have a tag with the owner's name, and current vaccination tags.



If you plan to use our pools, lakes or other facilities, please obey all posted rules. If you have any questions at any facility, please ask staff.
